

# What? You don't have a Solid State Drive in your PC yet?

A few years ago, replacing your computer's slow hard drive with a modern solid state drive (SSD) was quite the update in speed to be sure. But the price of an SSD with just enough space to hold the operating system and a few programs would set you back \$500 easily.

Well that was then, but now, you can get a new SSD that is not only fast, but has enough space to hold everything most folks need for as little as \$60 for a 240GB drive.

Need even more space, not a problem. You can purchase a 500GB SSD for just \$95.

## YES! 500GB of solid state for under \$100 – VERY WORTHWHILE INDEED!!

Still not enough space, well you can get a 1TB drive for just \$163 as of late October 2018!

So, once you get your new SSD installed, be sure to keep your old hard drive and use it for a backup! You can either install it in your PC as a second drive, or use it with a \$12 USB adaptor cable for your desktop or laptop.

Having an external backup drive allows you to store your backup drive in a safe place in case of fire, flood, or electrical damage to your computer. In fact, as long as we're on the subject, I would recommend that you have two backup drives and swap them out every other week. Ideally keep one of them at a friend's house, and return the favor for them. Just be sure to backup at least once per month (better yet every week) and swap them out routinely.


