



## Microsoft Windows 10 Fall Update - Due in October 2018

The Fall Update for Microsoft® Windows 10, also known as version 1809, is expected to be released in October of 2018. Like the Spring Update, this is a fairly major update that your PC will automatically install in the coming weeks, so be sure you're ready for it.

New features expected include an app named *Your Phone* which lets you text from your PC and instantly access photos from your Android phone from your PC. Also expected are some powerful new clipboard features such as a clipboard history that you'll be able to access by pressing the **Windows+V** keys.

Other items include a dark theme for File Explorer is expected with this update as well as the use of Swiftkey, the swipe-able virtual keyboard which comes from the Swiftkey company that Microsoft purchased in 2016.

Arguably one of the most useable new features is *Sets*. With Sets, almost every window on your desktop could now have a tab bar, and you could combine tabs from multiple different applications in the same window. You'll be able to drag and drop these tabs between windows to set things up how you'd like them. Once set, you can then switch between them via the **Ctrl+Windows+Tab** keys.

Search Preview. The search feature in the Start menu, aka the Cortana search feature, will now have search previews. As you start typing to search for something, now Windows will show you a preview pane with more information about your result.

A feature that that you might not use as much as others, the snipping tool, has been revamped and is now known as the *Snip & Sketch* tool. This tool now lets you draw on it and add annotations, including such things as arrows and highlights. This revamped screen snipping tool appears when you press the **Windows+Shift+S** keys. Also, there's a property under *Settings > Ease of Access > Keyboard* that can make this new tool appear when you press the Print Screen key on the keyboard, instead of its normal clipboard behavior.

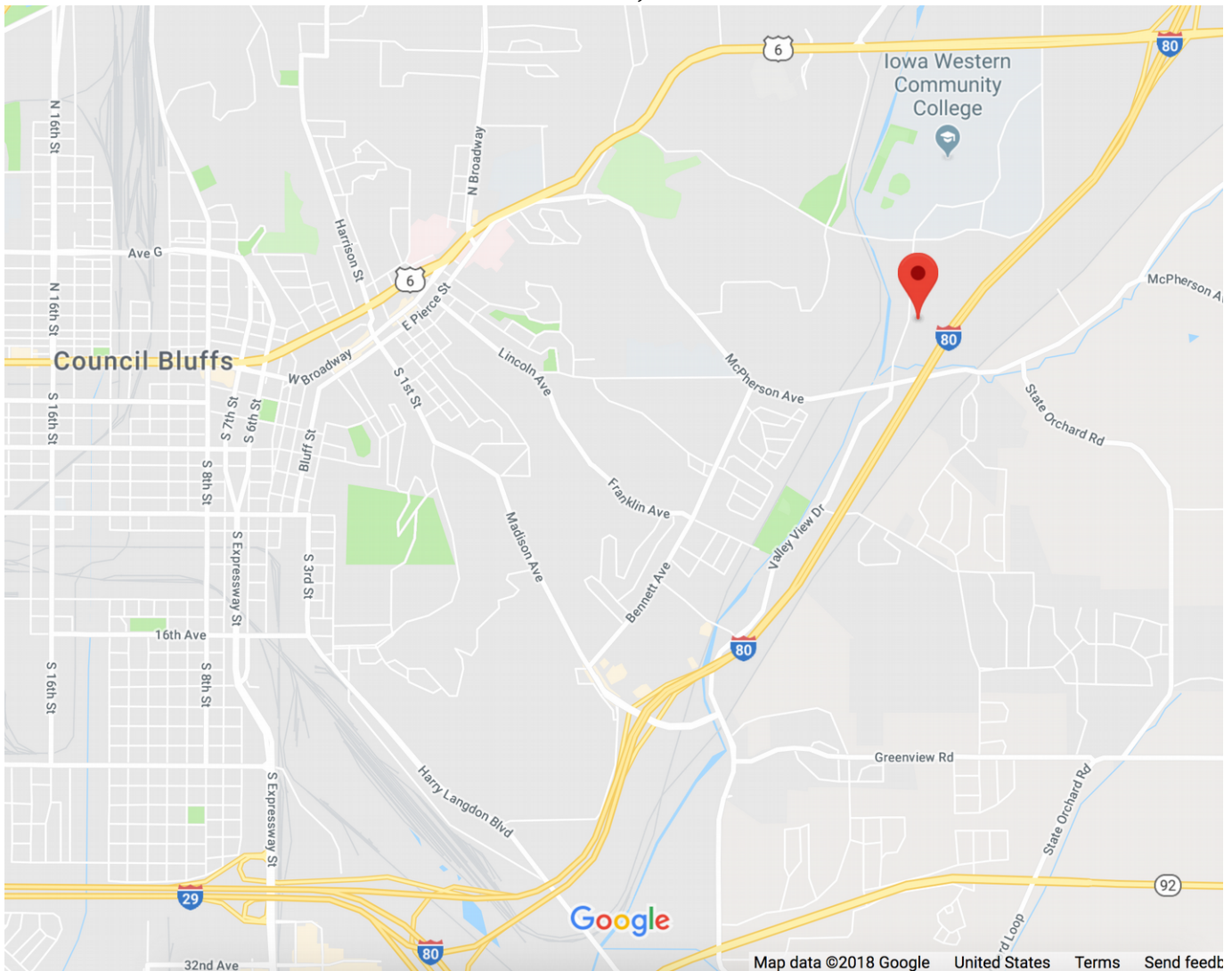
