Microsoft Price Increases for 2022

Microsoft has announced price increases for several *Microsoft 365* and *Office 365* subscription plans by as much as 25%. These increases are to take effect starting March 1, 2022.

Microsoft listed the new prices as:

- Microsoft 365 Business Basic, up \$1 to \$6 per month, per user.
- Microsoft 365 Business Premium, up \$2 to \$22 per month, per user.
- Office 365 E1, up \$2 to \$10 per month, per user.
- Office 365 E3, up \$3 to \$23 per month, per user.
- Office 365 E5, up \$3 to \$38 per month, per user.
- Microsoft 365 E3, up \$4 to \$36 per month, per user.

This made me think of how far the free alternatives have come as viable options over the years. For many home users and small businesses these are certainly worth trying out vs. feeding the software giant.
